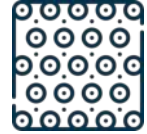

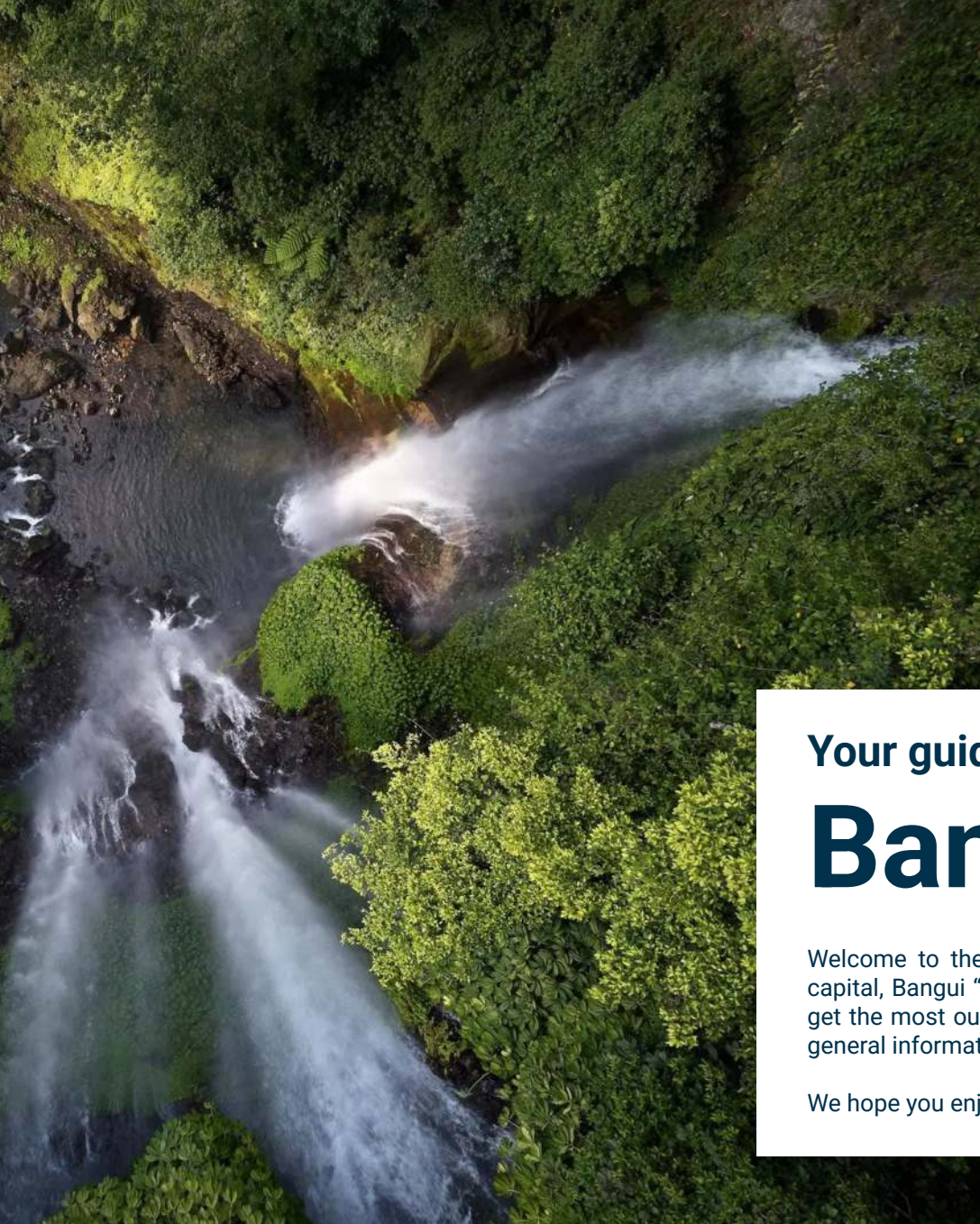

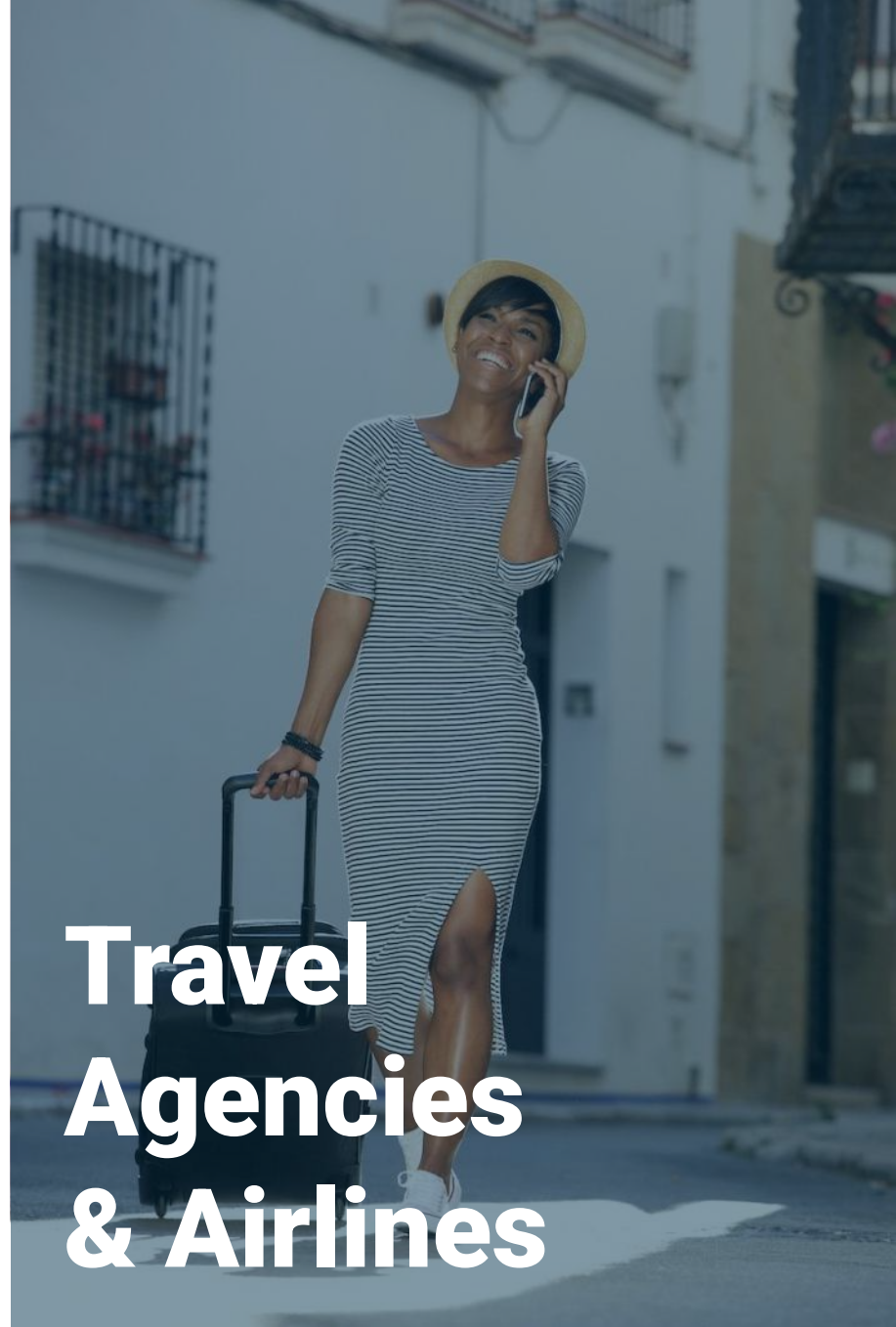

## Things to do

Explore the cultural heart of Bangui. Visit the Craft Village for unique handmade treasures, and don't miss iconic landmarks like Notre-Dame of Bangui Cathedral. Immerse yourself in the rich artistic and historical heritage of the Central African Republic.



### **Craft Village “Village artisanal”**

A sanctuary of local culture and craftsmanship. This vibrant space showcases the rich creative heritage of the country by highlighting the work of talented artisans. You'll find wooden sculptures, ritual masks, pottery, decorative art, and even paintings made using butterfly wings. Each piece reflects the diversity and depth of Central African traditions.

### **Cathedral Of Bangui**

The main Catholic place of worship in the capital and the seat of the Archdiocese of Bangui. Built in the 1930s, the cathedral is located in the city's 1st arrondissement and remains an important spiritual and architectural landmark.

### **Barthélemy Boganda National Museum**

The museum has been housed since 1964 in the former residence of President Boganda, founder of the Central African Republic. Dedicated to arts and popular traditions, it was one of the first museums in Africa to showcase artifacts representing the cultural heritage of the country's peoples.

### **Chutes de Boali (2-days trip)**

Boali Falls is one of the most iconic natural attractions in the country.

Located in the Ombella-M'Poko prefecture near Boali along the Mbali River, the falls rise to a height of 50 meters.

Since the 1950s, the power of these waterfalls has been harnessed to generate electricity for the city of Bangui.

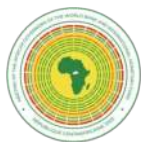
